A WORD FROM THE PRES

On behalf of the Committee, welcome to the lifesaving season 2021-22! I am sure that there will be many - like me - who are craving a 'normal' summer of catching up with friends, hot days on the beach and spending time at the club. Fingers crossed!

I want to open by thanking our many volunteers and few paid staff for all the work they have done to prepare us for the season ahead. Despite dealing with enough issues in their own work or family lives, this group of people has risen to the challenge of planning our activities based on as many as three or four scenarios given the unknown circumstances. I am incredibly grateful for this contribution.

The highlight of the off season was undoubtedly the individual accolades awarded to our members at LSV's Awards of Excellence, most notably Chris Perrott (Lifesaver of the Year), Andrew May (Youth Lifesaver of the Year) and Sas McNamara (Lifeguard of the Year). Portsea was also awarded LSV's Administration Club of the Year.

For the second season in a row, we head in with some uncertainty about how our operations will need to adapt because of the pandemic. The biggest change is the implementation of LSV's vaccination policy, requiring all members over 12 that wish to engage in patrols, programs or attend the clubhouse provide evidence of being fully vaccinated. Pleasingly, this change has been well-received by our members. More on this policy can be found in the LSV updates and on our website. I thank you in anticipation for your support as we endeavour to comply with the State and LSV requirements this season. Checking in, displaying your membership card, masks and social distancing will give us the best chance of delivering our members an uninterrupted season.

Our patrols have again commenced under the direction of our new Lifesaving Director Sas McNamara, with heightened precautions in place

for dealing with rescue and first aid scenarios. While keeping the beach safe is naturally our focus, more than ever we must protect our volunteers. We have a great team of leaders on the beach - whether it be first time Patrol Captain Oscar Hunter through to experienced returning Captains Marc Pizzi and Simon Knight or mentors such as Henry Kiss, Jim Unkles and James Nola. We are blessed with some amazing lifesaving talent.

Developing our people is a huge focus for the Club, so it was with a heavy heart that we were forced to postpone our Silver Camp, normally held in September. As I write this column, we are planning a revised Silver program to be held in December.

Fortunately, most other education programs will be able to continue, albeit with some changes. Led by Brett Croft, our nipper subcommittee has done a great job in preparing for the season and we have 600 nippers signed up for season 2021-22. That's the size of a primary school! Again, these will be split across two beaches, being Quarantine and Portsea Back Beach.

We are particularly excited this season to be introducing Starfish Nippers to Portsea for the first time. Starfish Nippers is an adapted Nipper Program for Nipper aged kids with a disability. It will run as part of the Nipper program at Quarantine, and we can't wait for it to start.

I must thank our Education Director Jacqui Hart who, along with her team has done a super job. Our SRC and Cadet programs are also heavily subscribed and will kick off in late December/early January. Bronze Camp this year will (hopefully) be delivered again as a residential program. Fingers crossed!

We can't wait to welcome you back to The Club and re-engage with our food and beverage offer. I will leave our GM Wayne Stoll to run through what to expect in his report, however we are

grateful that the doors are open again, giving our members the opportunity to catch up and enjoy life in their club.

After much planning, our open water swims will be back in January and February respectively. Entries for both are opening this month. We are also super-excited to be adding an adventure run to the Portsea Classic weekend. Keep an eye out for details of the Portsea Bay to Surf run.

Our yoga, pilates and bridge classes are also back, so please do get onto the website and book in for a class. These have been a great way for many members to engage in club activities. There is a lot to look forward to!

I'd like to thank all who have contributed to PSLSC in the off season, in particular members of the Committee and the Operations Committee, led by our Club Captain Jess Lamb, who are the engine room of the Club.

Rebranding

We have worked closely with Hayman Design to develop a new and refreshed brand style guide. The identity of the Portsea Surf Lifesaving Club is a valued asset that must be protected. The style guide is designed to maintain the integrity of the brand and to ensure that it is applied in an appropriate and consistent manner.

COMPETITION REPORT



Lockdown after lockdown has done nothing to dampen the enthusiasm of our Competition Teams, Junior, Senior, Masters and IRB Racing. The summer season climaxed with the Aussies in Queensland and results up North saw our highest ever number of athletes targeted for the LSV Sporting Excellence Program. Congratulations to Mackie Hunter, Harvey Larke, Xavier Purcell, Steph Hunter, Griffin Mitchell and Oscar Hunter on their nominations. In addition, our Open Women's Boat Crew joined the High Performance ranks – and secured a ticket to train as elite 'lockdown exempt' athletes. Our new IRB Racing Team managed to get four carnivals and the Victorian State Championships under their belt before COVID shut borders and the opportunity to race IRB Aussies. Despite their relative inexperience, our young team of twenty managed to impress at all carnivals and states. At Round 1 Portsea achieved 6th place overall in the open division with some amazing results including 2nd place Open Men's Tube, 3rd place Open Women's Tube and 1st U23 Men's Mass Rescue as well as many more finalists. The team's skills and capabilities only improved from then on, which

became very evident at the Victorian State Championships Carnival at Lorne on the first weekend of July. Portsea finished 7th overall in the open division, and 5th Overall in the U23 division. Considering the average age of the Team was just 20 years old, that was an amazing feat! We had a 1st place in U23 Women's Tube, 2nd place in Open Men's Tube and U23 Men's Tube, and 3rd place in Open Women's Tube, U23 Women's Rescue, Open Men's Rescue.

A huge congratulations goes to Sophie Courtney, who in her first season of IRB racing was able to score a Propellor Trophy, coming 2nd place in the Open Women's Tube rescue for the overall Premiership season along with her driver Sas McNamara. The most impressive thing about the season is how successfully the team came together. In addition to the enhancement of critical lifesaving skills, the IRB team helped to develop amazing friendships. A large portion of the team came from Sorrento SLSC and their previous experience and willingness to participate, highlights the benefits of cross-club collaboration. The outstanding results were really a testament to the commitment of

everyone involved. As always we would like to say a massive thanks to all the officials who helped us, as without them we wouldn't be allowed to race... Simon Wilson, Guy Davenport, Terry Aslandis, Alan (Aqua) Hales, Michael and Gayle Morris, Mick Cummins, and Stephen Blewett. Thank you also to our Team Manager Rebecca Morris. The Team is extremely excited to be starting training again. If you are interested in joining us, please contact Sas McNamara.

Back under 'Stay at Home' orders, self-motivation was once again needed to stay in top form over spring. In pairs and small groups, our competitors across all age groups from Under 8 to Masters have been spotted paddling on the Yarra, and bayside, swimming at Half Moon, surfing foamies at the Back Beach, doing 'Melbourne Cups' in Weroona Bay, pounding the pavement, sprinting the ovals and pumping weights in the home gyms. As the enthusiasm for on-line zoom workouts has waned, the warmer weather and increased travel limits have allowed many to get back into and on the water, the sand and the tracks. Some have even relocated to the beautiful Mt Levy precinct where 'after school sport' has taken on a somewhat more aquatic feel...and for those wondering, a 'Melbourne Cup' is four laps between the Portsea Pier and Police Point, totalling 3.2 km.

Our ski paddling group, led by Charlie Schall-Riaucour, has continued to expand through the winter months, and new faces, young and old, have appeared on the river and sea. Noah Cameron has been coaching some of our youth paddlers and through Paddle Australia, has encouraged thirteen of our younger Portsea athletes to sign up to a Talent Identification program with sights set on paddling towards Brisbane in 2032. Not everyone is aiming for lofty Olympic heights though - the Masters' paddling group has provided 'mental health' support, group fitness and camaraderie to our 'Old Bulls'. For some, it's been a long

two years and having friends beside you can mean a brighter light at the end of the tunnel.

Meanwhile, behind the scenes, our Competition Team Executive has been planning for the Red and White assault ahead. A ten day window between lockdowns allowed us to have both our board return nights, where our fleet of boards was inspected and re-allocated out to keen paddlers. As juniors and their parents transition to the Youth Team we are conscious of the importance of succession planning and handover of roles to our upcoming families. Amanda Benson and Matt Colston are handing over the Junior Manager reins this season as their boys look towards their final year in the junior ranks, stepping into supporting roles in the pre-season planning.

Growth of our competition team relies on a constant intake of young nippers into our junior competition team. With a disjointed winter sports program, on and off community sports training and competition, LSV's Aquatic Sports Lifesaving Competition is likely to be the first chance that many youngsters will have to complete a full season of competition for nearly two years. The lifesaving summer season is short,

culminating with the Victorian Junior Championships scheduled for the end of February. Our Junior Team is an inclusive, welcoming environment and presents a 'low pressure' opportunity for our young U8 – U13 members to regain their skills and confidence, with both individual and team events. The competitors will be supported by our junior team coaches Tom, Steph, Chloe and Emile. In addition Griffin Mitchell and Oscar Hunter will be starting up a "beachies" group and are planning to run early morning sessions accommodating all ages and abilities, both sprint and distance events. Growth of our beach area presents an exciting opportunity and potential to excel and both Victorian and Australian Championships.

Stephen Blewett once again will be heading up our rowers and recruitment is underway to get more 'bums on seats' in 21/22. The reports, stories and photos of the last Aussies has enthused a new cohort of open competitors who want to 'Come West with the Crew in 22' and head to Perth (pending borders of course) for the next Aussies – or up the East Coast somewhere should the venue be changed. The Masters team is also in recruitment mode with some of our 'younger bulls' ticking over the

mark to join Jim Unkles in the 30-35 year old age group. The U13 age group has recently been added to the Youth Aussies program so we might even see some of our Junior Competition Team journey across the Nullabor! The LSV Aquatic Sports Team has already needed to postpone and re-schedule a number of events including the State Team Trials and Victorian Endurance Championships. As we move out of lockdown and towards a hopefully more normal life, our competitors hope to pull on the red and white, show their stripes, have fun with their friends as they sprint across the sand and over the waves. We are bursting with energy and ready to race!! Please get on board, join the team and don't miss out on the excitement ahead. The Portsea Competition Team is welcoming of all new recruits regardless of ability. We have many roles needing filling – not just racing, but in team support, admin, officials, coaching, logistics and more. 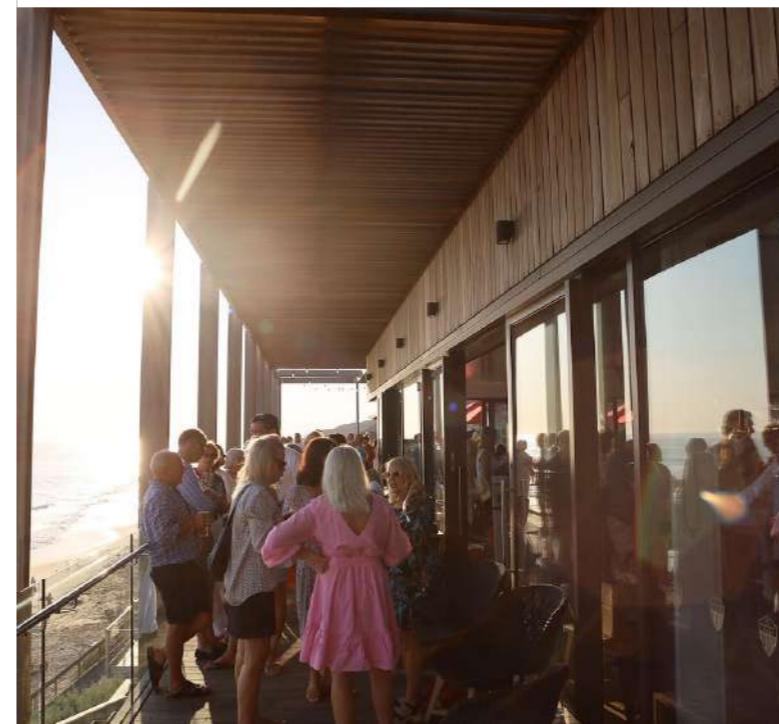

EQUIPMENT REPORT

With excitement for patrols, education programs, competition and alike beginning to ramp up, plenty of off-season groundwork has put into ensuring the club equipment and storage facilities are ready for the big few months of Summer. I've had plenty of great feedback from patrols, food and beverage staff, competition teams and others, to build on our current equipment processes and meet the needs of even more members. Wonderfully, two very keen candidates have offered their skills as Deputy Equipment Directors for the coming season, Tom Nelson and Spencer Thomas, who will be assisting with managing and facilitating programs and events with our growing swathe of equipment. I am looking forward to a well-deserved summer at the back beach with you all! Here is what to expect:

New Additions

This season, two ATVs will be stored at the clubhouse, allowing programs such as Nippers and education camps

to function independently of lifesaving operations, such as patrols and lifeguards. Both ATVs have been fitted with board racks on the roof, easing transportation of boards and improving our call-out capabilities. New semi-permanent signage has been installed along the ramp, allowing patrollers to communicate more information to beachgoers, with the flexibility of being stored inside on windy or unpatrolled days. Additionally, replacement boards and repairs of damaged boards will ensure that there are enough boards for whatever the occasion! Finally, there have been upgrades to the equipment room, including an air-compressor and roof-mounted storage system, allowing faster preparation, usage and storage of our equipment.

IRB Focus

As many of us have experienced, the Back Beach can be dangerous at the best of times, with certain days reserving even the bravest water-goers to the shoreline. Our Inflatable Rescue Boats (IRBs) serve as a powerful tool

in large swell, and when reaching swimmers is too slow or ineffective by board or tube. I would be happy to facilitate training programs, refresher courses, or upskilling programs to improve our rescue capabilities with these fantastic assets. hooded plover news, community sustainability efforts and art.
































